Deputies with the Acadia Parish Sheriff's Office have made an arrest regarding a Thursday evening armed robbery. The incident occurred at 5:09 pm on Maggie Lane near Church Point.

The initial report indicated that the suspect use his vehicle to cut off a vehicle driven by workers of an area farmer. The suspect exited his vehicle and demanded money. The suspect produced a handgun to the victim's and fled off with an undetermined amount of cash. Deputies were also provided with the suspect description, vehicle description and a partial license plate number.

At 7:23 pm, the patrol deputy spotted a vehicle in Church Point which matched the description of the suspect vehicle. Further investigation led to identifying the suspect in this armed robbery as well as recovery of the weapon used.

"This was an outstanding job done by our deputies. The work that was done to locate this suspect and close out this case with in a couple of hours, shows their dedication to resolving criminal activity in our parish. I am proud of how they serve our citizens" stated Sheriff KP Gibson.

Arrested was Zachary Daigle, 20 of Church Point. He has been charged with Armed Robbery and has been booked into the Acadia Parish Jail on a \$100,000 bond.
